







Reopening of 98th & Gibson Blvd. Intersection Postponed to Thursday, Sept. 5 Due to Weather; Stop Signs Will Be in Place in All Four Directions

Due to weather (recent rainfall), the reopening of the intersection of Gibson Blvd and 98th Street has been postponed to <u>late afternoonThursday</u>, <u>Sept. 5</u>, <u>2024</u>.

On that day, crews are scheduled to **reopen** the intersection of Gibson Blvd. and 98th Street to all traffic with stop signs in all directions at the intersection.

PLEASE NOTE: Crews are reopening the intersection because most of the work is completed.

However, due to the long lead time to order the new traffic signal, crews are scheduled to be back on the project to install the new traffic signal later in the fall of 2024.

We will notify everyone <u>in advance</u> when the traffic signal is scheduled to be installed.

IN THE MEANTIME, MOTORISTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO USE EXTRA CAUTION AT THE INTERSECTION AND OBEY THE STOP SIGNS.
